This has not happened in several years since only one member has run for each office. The Ring encourages members to become involved; therefore, the Ring is pleased that members want to be involved. Mike reminded the members to register for the IBM Jam on May 30th at the Airport Hilton Inn. This is free for any international member. Guest Performers/Lecturers scheduled are Ice McDonald, Charles Arkin, Shawn Farguhar and others not yet announced. Additional magicians are needed for Project Magic at Shriner's Hospital. Monthly, members visit Shriner's Hospital and entertain the patients and their families. Shriner's is moving to a new location soon and magicians are needed for June, July and December. Mike reminded the members to register for the Midwest Magic Jubilee, which is scheduled for August 13, 14, and 15. After this short meeting, Jay Scott Berry was the guest lecturer. Several of the members have seen him before; however, they still are amazed with the magic he performs. He shared that he has been a professional magician for over 35 years and has performed all over the world. According to his website he is a "world renowned Magician, Musician, Producer, Poet and Composer." He miraculously can make items appear and reappear.

Even the members who had front row seats did not know how he is able to do this (unless, of course, they have seen him before or watched his videos). He is constantly modifying his "gimmicks" for perfection. Members who have purchased his products in the past even bought the newer versions of the same products. The members really enjoyed the effect where he folded a piece of scrap paper and it changed into "bills." Other magicians perform this effect but use different techniques. Everything he performed "packs small but comes across big." During the break, he sold quite a few of his effects. After the break, he explained in detail topits, thumb tips, and sleeve pockets. His presentation was very interesting for the members. He even has developed a practical modern version of the Japanese Sinada. This allows the magician to be able to hold more items for productions, vanishes and transformations of silks, sponges, etc. He recommended that magicians should use high quality Japanese soft vinyl thumb tips when they are performing.

The members really enjoyed his lecture. He is such a fine magician but he is also an excellent presenter. The members purchased quite a few items during the break and after the lecture. The Ring feels very fortunate that they were able to book him and offer this lecture free to its members. Non-members were asked to pay \$20. Everyone commented that this was one of best lectures the Ring has ever offered.

Two of the Ring's members shared events that they are involved with. This month John Davit is performing at the St. Louis World's Fair Benefit Show which will be held at the 4 Seasons Hotel in St. Louis, Mo. Dr. Michael Henry leads ghost tours in St. Charles, Mo. In August he is performing at the Festival of the Little Hills in St. Charles. During this festival he will be performing European Style Street Shows. Also, on August 16th he will be featured on the SCI-FI Channel in a program featuring ghost hunters and the ghosts of St. Charles. If any Ring members visit St. Louis, it is recommended to go on one of his ghost tours.
